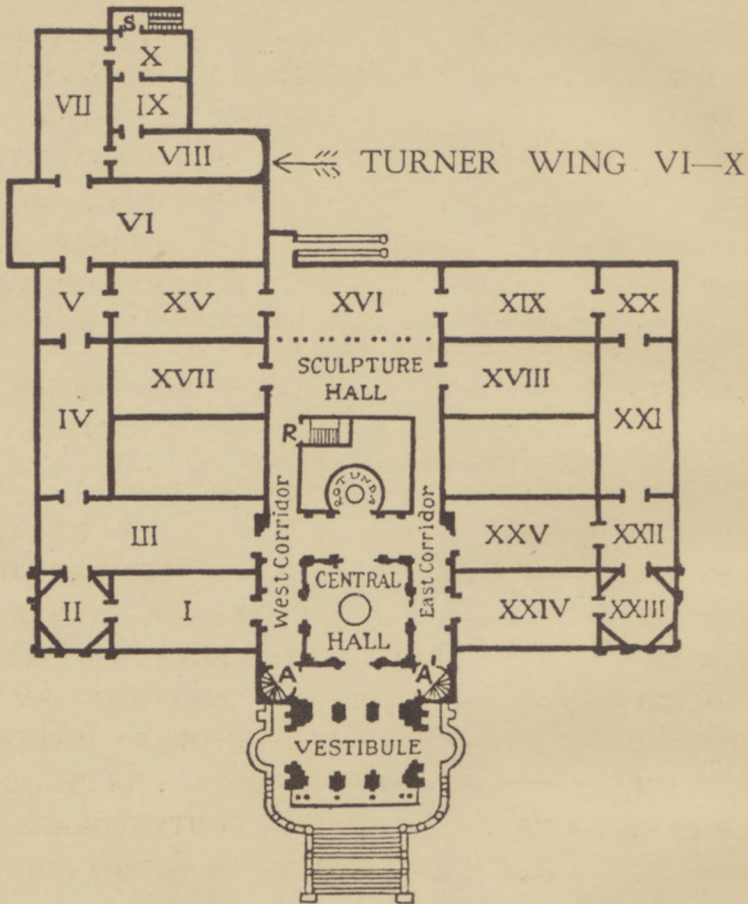

PLAN OF THE GALLERY



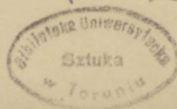
MAIN FLOOR

INTRODUCTION

THIS SELECTION OF ILLUSTRATIONS IS A COMPANION TO THE OFFICIAL CATALOGUE. IT CONTAINS ILLUSTRATIONS OF 173 PAINTINGS AND SCULPTURE IN THE NATIONAL COLLECTION, AND AN INDEX OF THE ARTISTS AND WORKS ILLUSTRATED ARRANGED IN ALPHABETICAL ORDER.

THE ILLUSTRATIONS ARE ARRANGED IN EIGHT SECTIONS, FOR THE MOST PART CHRONOLOGICALLY, CORRESPONDING WITH THE SEQUENCE OF THE GALLERIES. SECTION VII CONTAINS SCULPTURE (GALLERIES XVI AND XXIII) AND SECTION VIII THE TURNER COLLECTION (GALLERIES VI-X).
